The Journey So Far



- Original Pavilion In a Poor Condition
- Overwhelming Village Support for New Building
- Partly Funded by FA Grants.
- Grants Dependent on Partnership with,
 “Charter Standard Community Club”
- 5 Year Partnership with Royston Town FC



The Problem, Parking



- Higher Usage of the Recreational Ground
- Limited Use of Social Club and Village Hall Parking
- Only a Small Area for Parking to Support Usage of the Rec
- Reduces the Standard of the Product



The Problem, Overspill on to Cambridge Road

- Cambridge Road Used as an Overspill
- Reduced Down to Single Track
- Real Concerns for Both Pedestrians, Cyclists and Drivers
- Many Proposed New Houses, More Cars in the Future



The Solution, Grass Reinforcement Plastic Mesh

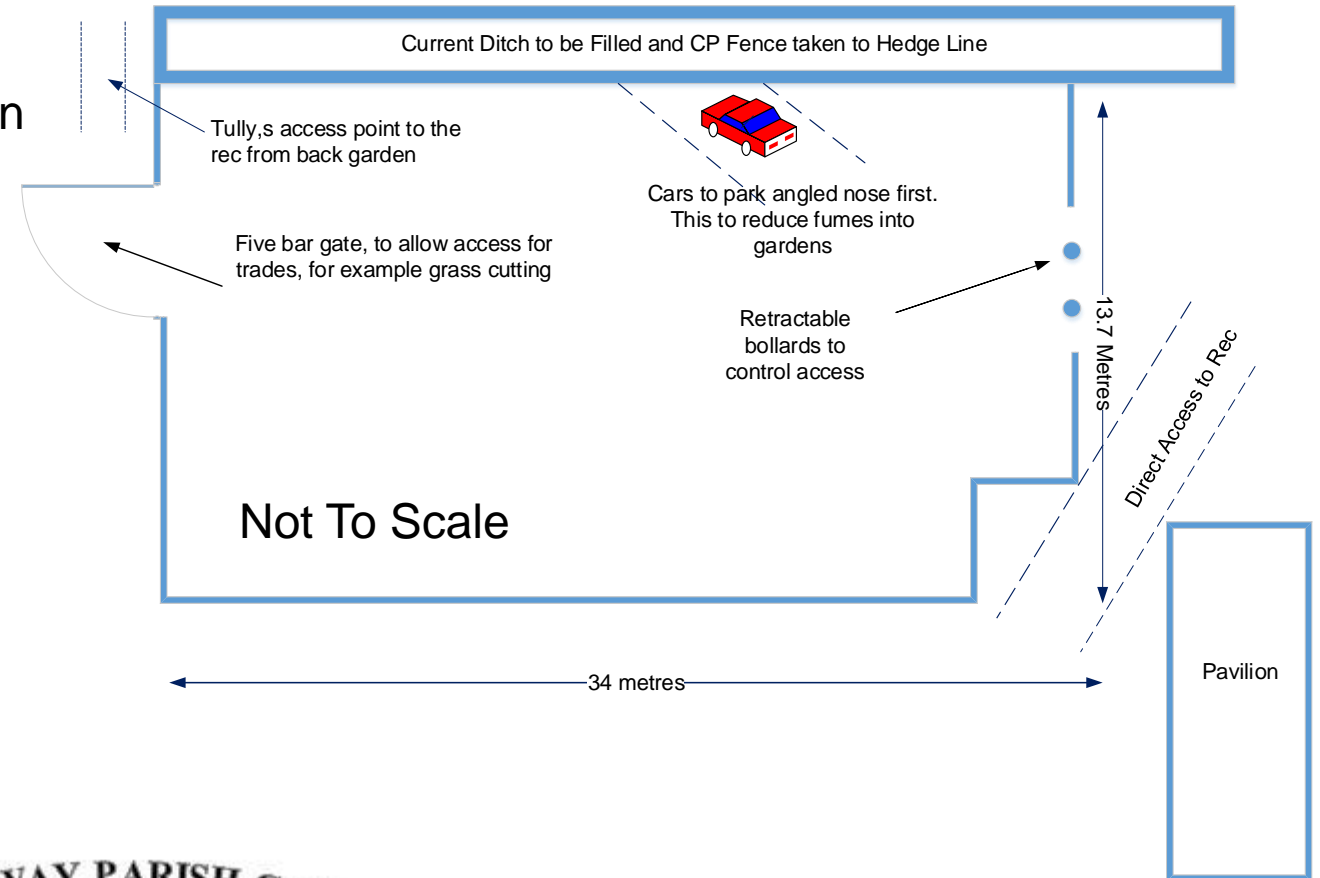


- Reasonably Priced Solution

- Reduced Construction Time
- Low Maintenance Cost

The Solution, Location, Size and Plan

- Children Play Area Relocated and Fenced In
- No Current Access To Rec Hampered
- No Hedgerows or Trees Removed
- Car Park Utilisation to be Controlled

Improvements

- Removal of car/vehicle access through play area.
- Creation of fenced in child friendly play area, meeting minimum safety standards, not currently met.
- Creation of fenced in grassed car park, only used when events on the Rec take place - secured at all other times.
- New safe route for vehicular access
